COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to Consumer Credit Code; amending 14A O.S. 2011, Section 5-106, which relates to discharge for garnishment; deleting language; prohibiting discharge from employment for garnishment; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 14A O.S. 2011, Section 5-106, is amended to read as follows:

Section 5-106. No employer shall discharge an employee for the reason that a creditor of the employee has subjected or attempted to subject unpaid earnings of the employee to garnishment or like proceedings directed to the employer for the purpose of paying a judgment arising from a debt, consumer credit sale, consumer lease, or consumer loan, ~~unless the employer shall be served with garnishment or like process issued to collect one or more judgments against the employee on more than two occasions within one year.~~

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2018.

1 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
2 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
3 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
4 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
