8	An Act relating to education organizations; amending 70 O.S. 2011, Section 5-139, which relates to
9	professional organization dues; removing requirement to make payroll deductions for certain purpose;
10	prohibiting school districts from making payroll deductions for membership dues in certain
11	organization; prohibiting school districts from paying membership or other participation dues to
12	certain organization; providing a definition; providing an effective date; and declaring an
13	emergency.

16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
17	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 70 O.S. 2011, Section 5-139, is
18	amended to read as follows:
19	Section 5-139. School A. Except as provided for in subsection
20	B of this section, school districts shall make payroll deductions
21	for either or both professional organization dues and political
22	contributions upon the request of any school employee and shall
23	transmit deducted funds to the organization designated by the school
24	district employee. <u>Such</u> <u>The</u> deductions shall be on a ten-month

basis unless otherwise designated by the employee organization. 1 2 However, a school employee may request in writing at any time for the school district to immediately terminate or initiate payroll 3 deductions to a professional organization. Upon receipt of a 4 5 request the school district shall within five (5) business days or by the next pay period, whichever is earlier, terminate or initiate 6 any future payroll deductions of the requesting school employee to a 7 professional organization. Upon receipt of a request the school 9 district shall notify the professional organization of the 10 initiation or termination of payroll deductions within fifteen (15) 11 business days. If the request is to terminate a deduction, the 12 school district shall not make any advance payments to any professional organization of any future dues on behalf of the school 13 employee. 14

- B. 1. It shall be unlawful for any school district to make payroll deductions on behalf of a school administrator for membership dues in a statewide organization that engages in political activity.
- 2. It shall also be unlawful for any school district to pay

 membership dues or any other participation fees on behalf of a

 school administrator for membership or participation in a statewide

 organization that engages in political activity.
