COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to firearms; providing for certain statewide or federally elected or appointed officials to carry a firearm; providing for carry while in performance of duties; requiring certain qualification course; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1,289.31 of Title 21, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The following statewide or federally elected or appointed officials may carry a firearm on his or her person throughout the state of Oklahoma, while in the performance of official duties of the office, if the person has successfully completed a handgun qualification course pursuant to the provisions of the Oklahoma Self Defense Act:

1. The Governor;
2. The Lieutenant Governor;

3. The State Auditor and Inspector;
4. The Secretary of State;
5. The Attorney General;
6. The State Treasurer;
7. The Superintendent of Public Instruction;
8. The Commissioner of Labor;
9. The Insurance Commissioner;
10. The Corporation Commissioners;
11. Members of the United States Senate from Oklahoma; and
12. Members of the United States House of Representatives from Oklahoma.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
