15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
16	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
17	codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:
18	Two members of the Oklahoma Commission on Children and Youth, or
19	his or her designees, and one representative from the Office of the
20	Governor shall work together to develop a plan for the consolidation
21	of the Oklahoma Commission on Children and Youth and the Office of
22	Disability Concerns. The consolidation plan shall be submitted to
23	the Governor, the President Pro Tempore of the Senate and the
24	Speaker of the House of Representatives by November 30, 2017.

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SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
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    of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
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    declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
    be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
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
