COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to agency consolidation; directing
certain persons to develop certain plan; requiring
submission of certain plan by certain date; providing
for noncodification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

Two members of the Oklahoma Commission on Children and Youth, or
his or her designees, and one representative from the Office of the
Governor shall work together to develop a plan for the consolidation
of the Oklahoma Commission on Children and Youth and the Office of
Disability Concerns. The consolidation plan shall be submitted to
the Governor, the President Pro Tempore of the Senate and the
Speaker of the House of Representatives by November 30, 2017.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
