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13	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
14	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
15	codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:
16	The Oklahoma Health Care Authority shall apply any increases in
17	Federal Medical Assistance Percentage (FMAP) rates to restore any
18	rate reductions to Medicaid providers, the highest priority being to
19	restore rate reductions to Medicaid-funded skilled nursing facility
20	services, including intermediate care facilities for individuals
21	with intellectual disability (ICF/IID) services, to one hundred
22	percent (100%) of audited reports of allowable costs in aggregate.
23	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2018.
