COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to skilled nursing facility services;
directing the Oklahoma Health Care Authority to use
certain federal funding increases for certain
purpose; providing for noncodification; providing an
effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

The Oklahoma Health Care Authority shall apply any increases in
Federal Medical Assistance Percentage (FMAP) rates to restore any
rate reductions to Medicaid providers, the highest priority being to
restore rate reductions to Medicaid-funded skilled nursing facility
services, including intermediate care facilities for individuals
with intellectual disability (ICF/IID) services, to one hundred
percent (100%) of audited reports of allowable costs in aggregate.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2018.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
