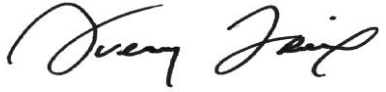



12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 15 O.S. 2011, Section 754, is
14 amended to read as follows:

15 Section 754. Nothing in ~~this act~~ the Oklahoma Consumer
16 Protection Act shall apply to:

17 1. Publishers, broadcasters, printers or other persons insofar
18 as an unlawful practice as defined in Section ~~3~~ 753 of this ~~act~~
19 title involves information that has been disseminated or reproduced
20 on behalf of others without knowledge that it is an unlawful
21 practice-;

22 2. Actions or transactions regulated under laws administered by
23 the Corporation Commission or any other regulatory body or officer
24 acting under statutory authority of this state or the United States,

1 or to acts done by retailers or other persons acting in good faith
2 on the basis of information or matter supplied by others and without
3 knowledge of the deceptive character of such information or matter;
4 and

5 3. The collection of monies denominated as gross receipts tax
6 on mixed beverages, sales tax, or use tax, or asserted injuries or
7 damages that are monies that have been collected as, or denominated
8 as, gross receipts tax on mixed beverages, sales tax, or use tax,
9 and which have been remitted to the Oklahoma Tax Commission or other
10 governmental taxing authority.

11 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
