17	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
18	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 60 O.S. 2011, Section 178.4, is
19	amended to read as follows:
20	Section 178.4 A. Trusts created under the provisions of
21	Sections 176 through 180.55 of this title or any amendments or
22	extensions thereof shall not include any trust purpose, function nor
23	activity primarily used in the distribution centers for intoxicating
24	beverages and low-point beer as defined in Title 37 of the Oklahoma

Statutes; nor shall it include a residential enterprise or function except as provided in Section 178.6 of this title. For the purposes of this section, "primarily used" shall mean more than fifty percent (50%) of the warehouse.
```

- B. Nothing in this section shall preclude the financing, construction, ownership or leasing of a warehouse as a permissible trust purpose, function or activity, so long as such warehouse is not <u>primarily</u> used <u>directly or indirectly</u> for housing, storage or distribution of intoxicating beverages or low-point beer.
- SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 60 O.S. 2011, Section 857, is amended to read as follows:

Section 857. A copy or a certified copy of all the recorded covenants and restrictions of a real estate development shall be provided by the title company upon the request of any closing the sale to the buyer of property in the real estate development as a part of the closing of the real estate sale. The buyer may be charged no more than Ten Dollars (\$10.00) Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) for the copy, and the copy shall be mailed no more than thirty (30) days from the date of the closing either be provided prior to or at the time of closing either by mail to the buyer's last-known address, hand-delivered or electronically delivered.

SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
