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14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
15	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 34.86.1 of Title 62, unless
17	there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
18	A. Not later than May 1 each year, the appropriations committee
19	of each chamber of the Legislature shall present general
20	appropriations measures that propose the substantial allocation of
21	available revenue as certified by the State Equalization Board
22	pursuant to Section 23 of Article X of the Oklahoma Constitution.
23	Each chamber shall conduct a vote on the final passage of these
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measures within not more than fifteen (15) days nor less than seven (7) days thereafter.

B. Upon the failure of the Legislature to comply with subsection A of this section, the Speaker of the House of Representatives shall cause to be presented directly to the entire House of Representatives the Governor's budget bill which upon approval by the House shall immediately proceed to the Senate for a vote on final passage without amendment. For the purposes of this section, "Governor's budget bill" shall mean legislation that substantially reflects the budget proposal presented to the Legislature by the Governor.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.

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
