COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to the Department of Human Services;
requiring certain appropriated funds to be used for
certain purposes; providing legislative intent;
providing for impact of restoration of funds on
remaining months of FY-18 budget; and declaring an
emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. It is the intent of the Oklahoma Legislature that
the Department of Human Services fully fund in its entirety the
Advantage Home and Community-based Waiver Program, Money Follows the
Person, Homeward Bound Waiver, In-home Supports, Advantage Waiver,
Personal Care and state-funded community residential and vocational
services within the Department of Human Services in FY-2018 with all
of the state, federal, and other existing financial resources

1 available to the Department, including increasing state funds to
2 make up for the loss of Federal FMAP funds so that total spending in
3 FY-2018 is not reduced based on the initial budgeted resources
4 available at the beginning of FY-18 taking into account restoration
5 of funds pursuant to actions and enactments occurring as a result of
6 the Extraordinary Sessions of the 56th Oklahoma Legislature and the
7 impact of such funds on the remaining months of the FY-18 budget.
8 It is further the Oklahoma Legislature's intent that services to
9 clients and related provider rates within the Advantage Home and
10 Community-based Waiver Program, Money Follows the Person, Homeward
11 Bound Waiver, In-home Supports, Advantage Waiver, Personal Care and
12 state-funded community residential and vocational services not be
13 reduced below contracted rates in effect at the beginning of FY-18
14 taking into account restoration of funds pursuant to actions and
15 enactments occurring as a result of the Extraordinary Sessions of
16 the 56th Oklahoma Legislature and the impact of such funds on the
17 remaining months of the FY-18 budget.

18 SECTION 2. It is the intent of the Oklahoma Legislature that
19 the Department of Human Services fully fund the Adult Day Services
20 in FY-2018 with all of the state, federal, and other existing
21 financial resources available to the Department of Human Services,
22 including increasing state funds to make up for the loss of Federal
23 FMAP funds so that total spending in FY-2018 is no less than the
24 initial budgeted amount in effect at the beginning of FY-18 taking

1 into account restoration of funds pursuant to actions and enactments
2 occurring as a result of the Extraordinary Sessions of the 56th
3 Oklahoma Legislature and the impact of such funds on the remaining
4 months of the FY-18 budget. It is further the Oklahoma
5 Legislature's intent that services to current Adult Day Services
6 clients and related provider rates to such clients not be reduced
7 below contracted rates in effect at the beginning of FY-18 taking
8 into account restoration of funds pursuant to actions and enactments
9 occurring as a result of the Extraordinary Sessions of the 56th
10 Oklahoma Legislature and the impact of such funds on the remaining
11 months of the FY-18 budget.

12 SECTION 3. It is the intent of the Oklahoma Legislature that
13 the Department of Human Services for FY-2018 set foster care,
14 residential, intensive in-home services, group home care and
15 adoption subsidy rates at the same level in effect at the beginning
16 of FY-18 taking into account restoration of funds pursuant to
17 actions and enactments occurring as a result of the Extraordinary
18 Sessions of the 56th Oklahoma Legislature and the impact of such
19 funds on the remaining months of the FY-18 budget.

20 SECTION 4. It is the intent of the Oklahoma Legislature that
21 the Department of Human Services fund the Senior Nutrition Program
22 within the Aging Services Division in FY-2018 with all of the state,
23 federal, and other existing financial resources available to the
24 Department at or above the amount in effect at the beginning of FY-

1 18 taking into account restoration of funds pursuant to actions and
2 enactments occurring as a result of the Extraordinary Sessions of
3 the 56th Oklahoma Legislature and the impact of such funds on the
4 remaining months of the FY-18 budget.

5 SECTION 5. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
6 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
7 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
8 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
