9 An Act relating to schools; defining per-pupil
10 expenditure; listing expenditure categories;
11 excluding certain expenditures; providing for
12 application; requiring the reporting or publishing of
13 certain categories; providing for codification; and
14 providing an effective date.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
17 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-124 of Title 70, unless there
18 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

19 A. Unless otherwise specifically defined, "per-pupil
20 expenditure" shall mean the aggregate current expenditures of school
21 districts, from all funding sources including federal funds, state
22 funds and local funds, plus the direct support aggregate current
23 expenditures of the state for the day-to-day operations of schools
24 and school districts from all funding sources including federal

1 funds, divided by the aggregate student membership number for the
2 same fiscal year for which the expenditures are determined. The
3 aggregate student membership number shall be the count of students
4 enrolled on October 1 or the school day closest to October 1 to whom
5 school districts in the state provide a public education. The
6 aggregate current expenditures shall include without limitation the
7 following categories of expenditures:

- 8 1. Instruction;
- 9 2. Support services students;
- 10 3. Support services instructional staff;
- 11 4. Support services general administration;
- 12 5. Support services school administration;
- 13 6. Support services business;
- 14 7. Operation and maintenance of plant services;
- 15 8. Student transportation services;
- 16 9. Child nutrition services; and
- 17 10. Enterprise services.

18 B. Aggregate current expenditures shall not include
19 expenditures for adult and community education, facilities
20 acquisition and construction services, debt services, property, and
21 other expenditures not related to the day-to-day operations.

22 C. The provisions of subsection A of this section shall apply
23 when related to the expenditure of public funds by educational and
24 governmental entities. When reporting or publishing the per-pupil

1 expenditure for any purpose, the State Department of Education shall
2 also report or publish each category of expenditure as listed in
3 subsection A of this section as well as the aggregate expenditure.

4 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.

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
