SUBCOMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION

An Act relating to cities and towns; creating the Oklahoma Municipal Safe Lighting Matching Grant Revolving Fund; providing for sources of revenue; authorizing expenditures; prescribing method for expenditures; imposing duty on Oklahoma Department of Commerce with respect and private funds; providing for codification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

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3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

4       SECTION 1.       NEW LAW       A new section of law to be codified  
5 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 40-125 of Title 11, unless there  
6 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:  
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8       There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund  
9 for the Oklahoma Department of Commerce to be designated the  
10 "Oklahoma Municipal Safe Lighting Matching Grant Revolving Fund".  
11 The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year  
12 limitations, and shall consist of all monies received by the  
13 Oklahoma Department of Commerce from private donations and such  
14 other sources as may be provided by law. All monies accruing to the  
15 credit of said fund are hereby appropriated and may be budgeted and  
16 expended by the Oklahoma Department of Commerce for the purpose of  
17 providing matching grants to eligible municipalities in order to  
18 provide safe lighting in designated high-risk areas. Expenditures  
19 from said fund shall be made upon warrants issued by the State  
20 Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by law with the  
21 Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services for  
22 approval and payment.  
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1       SECTION 2.       NEW LAW

2       A new section of law to be codified  
3 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 40-126 of Title 11, unless there  
4 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

5       The Oklahoma Department of Commerce shall work in cooperation  
6 with business entities, nonprofit organizations and foundations in  
7 order to manage privately donated funds to implement the provisions  
8 of this act.

9       SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 2017.

10       SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
11 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby  
12 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
13 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
