COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to motor vehicles; amending 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.5, as last amended by Section 25, Chapter 210, O.S.L. 2016 (47 O.S. Supp. 2016, Section 1135.5), which relates to demonstration of support and financial assistance special license plates; creating the Oklahoma Aeronautics Commission License Plate; establishing plates as financial assistance license plates; providing for design of license plates; requiring certain portion of fees be deposited in certain fund; amending 3 O.S. 2011, Section 91, as amended by Section 21, Chapter 304, O.S.L. 2012 (3 O.S. Supp. 2016, Section 91), which relates to the Oklahoma Aeronautics Commission Revolving Fund; authorizing deposit of certain fees; authorizing expenditure of funds for certain purpose; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.5, as last amended by Section 25, Chapter 210, O.S.L. 2016 (47 O.S. Supp. 2016, Section 1135.5), is amended to read as follows:

Section 1135.5 A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby authorized to design and issue appropriate official special license

1 plates to persons wishing to demonstrate support and provide
2 financial assistance as provided by this section.

3 Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other
4 person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of
5 ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used
6 on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been
7 registered for the current year with a motor license agent.

8 Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax
9 Commission or a motor license agent. The Tax Commission shall
10 annually notify by mail all persons issued special license plates.
11 The notice shall contain all necessary information and shall contain
12 instructions for the renewal procedure upon presentation to a motor
13 license agent or the Tax Commission. The license plates shall be
14 issued on a staggered system.

15 The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a
16 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept
17 applications for special license plates authorized under this
18 section. The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's
19 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount
20 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary
21 information directly into such system and generate a receipt
22 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents
23 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for
24 registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for

1 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the
2 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

3 If fewer than one hundred of any type of special license plates
4 authorized prior to January 1, 2004, are issued prior to January 1,
5 2006, the Tax Commission shall discontinue issuance and renewal of
6 that type of special license plate. Any such authorized special
7 license plate registrant shall be allowed to display the license
8 plate upon the designated vehicle until the registration expiration
9 date. After such time the expired special license plate shall be
10 removed from the vehicle.

11 For special license plates authorized on or after July 1, 2004,
12 no special license plates shall be developed or issued by the Tax
13 Commission until the Commission receives one hundred prepaid
14 applications therefor. The prepaid applications must be received by
15 the Tax Commission within one hundred eighty (180) days of the
16 effective date of the authorization or the authority to issue shall
17 be null and void. In the event one hundred prepaid applications are
18 not received by the Tax Commission within such prescribed time
19 period any payment so received shall be refunded accordingly.

20 B. The special license plates provided by this section are as
21 follows:

22 1. University or College Supporter License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such
23 plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
24 demonstrate support to any state-supported or private university or

1 college. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee
2 collected shall be apportioned as provided in Section 1104.1 of this
3 title;

4 2. Environmental Awareness License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such plates
5 shall be designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the
6 Tax Commission by the Department of Environmental Quality in
7 consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any
8 person wishing to demonstrate support to implement the statewide
9 general public environmental education program created pursuant to
10 the provisions of the Oklahoma Environmental Quality Code. Such
11 plates shall be designed and issued to any person in any combination
12 of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for
13 personalized license plates. A dealer's license plate issued
14 pursuant to Section 1116.1 or 1128 of this title may be designated
15 an Environmental Awareness License Plate upon payment of the fee
16 imposed by this section and any other registration fees required by
17 the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act. As provided in
18 this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned
19 pursuant to Section 1104.2 of this title;

20 3. Firefighter License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such plates shall be
21 designed for any career or retired firefighter, volunteer or paid.
22 Firefighters may apply for firefighter plates for up to four
23 vehicles with a rated capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a
24 motorcycle upon proof of a fire department membership by either an

1 identification card or letter from the chief of the fire department.
2 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of
3 eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to
4 provide proof of eligibility annually. The surviving spouse of any
5 deceased firefighter, if the spouse has not since remarried, may
6 apply for a firefighter license plate for one vehicle with a rated
7 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a motorcycle upon
8 proof that the deceased firefighter was a member of a fire
9 department by either an identification card or letter from the chief
10 of the fire department. The license plate shall be designed in
11 consultation with the Oklahoma Firefighters Association.

12 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
13 shall be deposited to the Oklahoma State Firemen's Museum Building &
14 Memorial Fund for support of the Oklahoma Firefighters Museum and
15 the Oklahoma ~~Firefighter~~ Fallen and Living Firefighters Memorial;

16 4. Wildlife Conservation License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such plates
17 shall be designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the
18 Tax Commission by the Oklahoma Department of Wildlife Conservation
19 in consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any
20 person wishing to demonstrate support for wildlife conservation in
21 this state through the Wildlife Diversity Fund, provided for in
22 Section 3-310 of Title 29 of the Oklahoma Statutes. Such plates may
23 be designed and issued to any person as for personalized license
24 plates.

1 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
2 shall be apportioned pursuant to subsection D of Section 3-310 of
3 Title 29 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

4 5. Child Abuse Prevention License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such plates
5 shall be designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the
6 Tax Commission by the Office of Child Abuse Prevention in the State
7 Department of Health and the Oklahoma Committee to Prevent Child
8 Abuse, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
9 the prevention of child abuse.

10 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
11 shall be deposited in the Child Abuse Prevention Fund;

12 6. United States Olympic Committee Supporter License ~~Plates~~
13 Plate - such plates shall be designed and issued to any person
14 wishing to demonstrate support for the United States Olympic
15 Committee. The plates shall be issued to any person in any
16 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven,
17 as for personalized license plates. The plate shall contain the
18 official United States Olympic Committee logo. The Tax Commission
19 shall be authorized, if necessary, to enter into a licensing
20 agreement with the United States Olympic Committee for any licensing
21 fees which may be required in order to use the United States Olympic
22 Committee logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide for
23 a payment of not more than Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) for each
24 license plate issued;

1 7. Oklahoma History License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such plates shall be
2 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate interest in
3 Oklahoma history. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee
4 collected shall be deposited to the Oklahoma Historical Society
5 Revolving Fund to be used for educational purposes;

6 8. Historic Route 66 License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such plates shall
7 be designed to honor historic Route 66, also known as the "Mother
8 Road". As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
9 shall be apportioned to the Oklahoma Historical Society Revolving
10 Fund to be distributed to the Route 66 Museum located in Clinton,
11 Oklahoma;

12 9. Heart of the Heartland License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such plates
13 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to honor the
14 victims of the terrorist bombing attack on the Alfred P. Murrah
15 Federal Building in downtown Oklahoma City on April 19, 1995. As
16 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
17 deposited in the Heart of the Heartland Scholarship Fund, as
18 established in Section 2282 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

19 10. Emergency Medical Technician License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such
20 plates shall be designed and issued to any person who is an
21 emergency medical technician. Such persons may apply for an
22 emergency medical technician license plate for each vehicle with a
23 rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of an
24 emergency medical technician's license. The license plate shall be

1 designed in consultation with the state association of emergency
2 medical technicians. As provided in this section, an amount of the
3 fee collected shall be apportioned to the Emergency Medical
4 ~~Technician~~ Personnel Death Benefit Revolving Fund created in Section
5 1-2505.2 of Title 63 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

6 11. Fight Breast Cancer License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such plates
7 shall be designed to demonstrate support for the prevention and
8 treatment of breast cancer in this state. As provided in this
9 section, an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned to the
10 Breast Cancer Act Revolving Fund;

11 12. Crime Victims Awareness License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such plates
12 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
13 awareness of and support for victims of crimes. The license plates
14 shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Crime Victims
15 Centre. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
16 shall be apportioned to the Attorney General's Revolving Fund for
17 the Office of the Attorney General, which is hereby directed to use
18 such funds to contract with a statewide nonprofit organization to
19 provide services to crime victims;

20 13. Oklahoma Safe Kids Association License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such
21 plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
22 demonstrate support and awareness of the Oklahoma Safe Kids
23 Association. The license plate shall be designed in consultation
24 with the Oklahoma Safe Kids Association. As provided in this

1 section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited in the
2 Children's Hospital - Oklahoma Safe Kids Association Revolving Fund
3 to be distributed to the Oklahoma Safe Kids Association program;

4 14. Four-H Club License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such plates shall be
5 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission
6 by the Four-H Foundation, and issued to any person wishing to
7 demonstrate support of the Four-H Club. Such plates may be designed
8 and issued to any person as for personalized license plates. As
9 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
10 apportioned to the OSU Extension Service License Plate Revolving
11 Fund created in Section 1104.4 of this title;

12 15. Agricultural Awareness License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such plates
13 shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax
14 Commission, by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and
15 Forestry in consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued
16 to any person wishing to demonstrate support of the Department's Ag
17 in the Classroom Education Program. As provided in this section, an
18 amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in
19 Section 1104.3 of this title;

20 16. Oklahoma Statehood Centennial License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such
21 plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
22 commemorate the centennial of Oklahoma's admission to statehood in
23 1907. The license plates shall be designed in consultation with the
24 Oklahoma Capitol Complex and Centennial Commemoration Commission.

1 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
2 deposited in the Oklahoma Capitol Complex and Centennial
3 Commemoration Commission Revolving Fund created in Section 98.5 of
4 Title 73 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

5 17. Support Education License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such plates shall
6 be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax
7 Commission by the State Department of Education in consultation with
8 the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any person wishing to
9 demonstrate support for education in this state. All motor license
10 agents shall display a sample of the Support Education License plate
11 in the area of the business accessed by the public. Twenty-three
12 Dollars (\$23.00) of the fee collected shall be apportioned as
13 follows:

- 14 a. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the Education
15 Reform Revolving Fund,
- 16 b. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the Higher
17 Education Revolving Fund,
- 18 c. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the State
19 Career Technology Fund, and
- 20 d. eighty-five percent (85%) of the fee shall be
21 deposited to the Teachers' Retirement Benefit Fund as
22 set forth in Section 17-108 of Title 70 of the
23 Oklahoma Statutes.

1 However, when the Teachers' Retirement Benefit Fund attains a
2 seventy percent (70%) funded ratio based on an annual actuarial
3 valuation as required by law, the amount of the fee shall be
4 apportioned equally pursuant to subparagraphs a, b and c of this
5 paragraph;

6 18. Retired Oklahoma Highway Patrol Officers License ~~Plates~~
7 Plate - such plates shall be designed and issued to any retired
8 officer of the Oklahoma Highway Patrol. The license plate shall
9 have the legend "Oklahoma" and shall contain, in the center of the
10 plate, the Highway Patrol Officers patch using the same colors and
11 pattern as used in the patch. Centered on the bottom of the license
12 plate shall be the word "Retired". The letters "TRP" shall be used
13 in combination with three numbers on either side of the insignia or
14 emblem. The color of the letters and numbers shall be brown.
15 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of
16 eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to
17 provide proof of eligibility annually. The surviving spouse of any
18 deceased retired officer of the Oklahoma Highway Patrol, if the
19 spouse has not since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is
20 terminated by death, divorce, or annulment, may apply for a Retired
21 Oklahoma Highway Patrol Officers license plate. As provided in this
22 section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited into the
23 Law Enforcement Retirement Fund;

1 19. Boy Scouts of America Supporter License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such
2 plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
3 demonstrate support for the Boy Scouts of America. The plates shall
4 be issued to any person in any combination of numbers and letters
5 from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates.
6 The plate shall contain the official Boy Scouts of America logo.
7 The Tax Commission shall be authorized, if necessary, to enter into
8 a licensing agreement with the Boy Scouts of America for any
9 licensing fees which may be required in order to use the Boy Scouts
10 of America logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide
11 for a payment to the Boy Scouts of America of not more than Twenty
12 Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

13 20. Urban Forestry and Beautification License ~~Plates~~ Plate -
14 such plates shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented
15 to the Tax Commission, by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture,
16 Food, and Forestry in consultation with nonprofit organizations in
17 this state that develop and operate programs to encourage urban
18 forestry and beautification, and issued to any person wishing to
19 demonstrate support of such programs. As provided in this section,
20 an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in
21 Section 1104.5 of this title;

22 21. Oklahoma State Parks Supporter License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such
23 plates shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the
24 Tax Commission by the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department,

1 and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the
2 Oklahoma state parks system. Twenty-three Dollars (\$23.00) of the
3 fee collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Tourism and
4 Recreation Department Revolving Fund. Such money shall be
5 designated for and may only be expended for the support of Oklahoma
6 state parks;

7 22. Adoption Creates Families License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such
8 plates shall be issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support
9 of pregnant women who are committed to placing their children for
10 adoption and wishing to provide assistance to guardians, adoptive
11 parents and other created families to assist in the adoption and
12 placement of children in permanent, safe homes. The license plates
13 shall be designed and final terminology delivered in consultation
14 with the Oklahoma Adoption Coalition and the Department of Human
15 Services. Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) of the fee collected shall
16 be deposited in a revolving fund established in the State Treasury
17 for and to be used by the Department of Human Services for the
18 implementation of the Investing in Stronger Oklahoma Families Act
19 specifically for created families;

20 23. Choose Life License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such plates shall be
21 designed, subject to criteria presented to the Tax Commission, by
22 Choose Life, Inc., and issued to any person who wishes to
23 demonstrate support of organizations that encourage adoption as a
24 positive choice for women with unplanned pregnancies. As provided

1 in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited
2 in the Choose Life Assistance Program Revolving Fund established in
3 Section 1104.6 of this title;

4 24. Future Farmers of America License Plate - such plates shall
5 be designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for
6 the Oklahoma FFA (formerly known as Future Farmers of America). The
7 license plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma
8 FFA Foundation Board of Directors. As provided in this section, an
9 amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in
10 Section 1104.7 of this title;

11 25. Lions Club License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such plates shall be
12 designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for
13 the Lions Club of Oklahoma. The plates shall be issued to any
14 person in any combination of numbers and letters from one to a
15 maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates. The license
16 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Lions
17 Service Foundation and shall contain the official logo of the
18 International Association of Lions Clubs. The Tax Commission shall
19 be authorized to enter into a licensing agreement with the Oklahoma
20 Lions Service Foundation. The licensing agreement shall provide for
21 a payment to the Oklahoma Lions Service Foundation of not more than
22 Ten Dollars (\$10.00) for each license plate issued;

23 26. Color Oklahoma License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such plates shall be
24 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission

1 by the Oklahoma Native Plant Society, and issued to any person
2 wishing to demonstrate support for preserving and planting
3 wildflowers and native plants in Oklahoma and to promote Oklahoma's
4 wildflower heritage through education. As provided in this section,
5 an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in
6 Section 1104.8 of this title;

7 27. Girl Scouts of the United States of America Supporter
8 License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such plates shall be designed and issued to
9 any person wishing to demonstrate support for the Girl Scouts of the
10 United States of America. The plates shall be issued to any person
11 in any combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of
12 seven, as for personalized license plates. The plate shall contain
13 the official Girl Scouts of the United States of America logo. The
14 Tax Commission shall be authorized, if necessary, to enter into a
15 licensing agreement with the Girl Scouts of the United States of
16 America for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use
17 the Girl Scouts of the United States of America logo or design. The
18 licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to the Girl Scouts
19 of Magic Empire Council, acting on behalf of all Oklahoma Girl Scout
20 councils, of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license
21 plate issued;

22 28. Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such
23 plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
24 demonstrate support for the Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon. The

1 plate shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma City
2 Memorial Marathon. The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter
3 into a licensing agreement with the Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon
4 for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use the
5 Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon logo or design. The licensing
6 agreement shall provide for a payment to the Oklahoma City Memorial
7 Marathon of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license
8 plate issued;

9 29. Oklahoma Scenic Rivers License Plate - such plates shall be
10 designed to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma Scenic Rivers. The
11 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Scenic
12 Rivers Commission. Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) of the fee shall be
13 apportioned to the Oklahoma Scenic Rivers Commission;

14 30. Fight Cancer License Plate - such plates shall be designed
15 to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma Central Cancer Registry.
16 The plate shall contain the American Cancer Society logo. The
17 American Cancer Society logo shall be used in accordance with the
18 American Cancer Society's branding guidelines and shall only be
19 utilized to support the Oklahoma Central Cancer Registry. Twenty
20 Dollars (\$20.00) of the fee shall be apportioned to the Oklahoma
21 Central Cancer Registry Revolving Fund;

22 31. Animal Friendly License Plate - such plates shall be
23 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
24 controlling the overpopulation of dogs and cats through educational

1 and sterilization efforts. The plates shall be designed in
2 consultation with the Veterinary Medical Association. Twenty
3 Dollars (\$20.00) of the fee collected shall be designated by the
4 purchaser of the plate to be deposited in the Oklahoma Pet
5 Overpopulation Fund created in Section 2368.13 of Title 68 of the
6 Oklahoma Statutes or the Animal Friendly Revolving Fund created in
7 Section 1104.10 of this title;

8 32. Patriot License Plate - such plates shall be designed in
9 consultation with the Military Department of Oklahoma and issued to
10 any person wishing to demonstrate support for Oklahoma residents who
11 are members of the Oklahoma National Guard and deployed on active
12 duty. The plates shall be issued to any person in any combination
13 of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for
14 personalized license plates. As provided in this section, a portion
15 of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Patriot License Plate
16 Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.11 of this title;

17 33. Global War on Terrorism License Plate - such plate shall be
18 designed in consultation with the Military Department of Oklahoma
19 and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for Oklahoma
20 residents who are members of the Armed Forces of the United States
21 or Oklahoma National Guard that have served in the Global War on
22 Terrorism. The plate shall be issued to any person in any
23 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of six. As
24 provided in this section, a portion of the fee collected shall be

1 deposited in the 45th Infantry Division Museum Fund created in
2 Section 235.1 of Title 44 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

3 34. Boys and Girls Clubs of America Supporter License ~~Plates~~
4 Plate - such plates shall be designed and issued to any person
5 wishing to demonstrate support for the Boys and Girls Clubs of
6 America. The plates shall be issued to any person in any
7 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven,
8 as for personalized license plates. The plate shall contain the
9 official Boys and Girls Clubs of America logo. The Tax Commission,
10 if necessary, may enter into a licensing agreement with the Boys and
11 Girls Clubs of America for any licensing fees which may be required
12 in order to use the Boys and Girls Clubs of America logo or design.
13 The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to the Boys and
14 Girls Clubs of America of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for
15 each license plate issued;

16 35. Oklahoma Quarter Horse License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such plates
17 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
18 support for the American Quarter Horse in Oklahoma. The plate shall
19 be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Quarter Horse
20 Association. As provided in this section, a portion of the fee
21 collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Quarter Horse Revolving
22 Fund created in Section 1104.12 of this title;

23 36. Oklahoma Association for the Deaf License Plate - such
24 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma

1 Association for the Deaf and issued to any person wishing to
2 demonstrate support for Oklahoma residents who are deaf. The plates
3 shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers and
4 letters from one to maximum of seven, as for personalized license
5 plates. As provided in this section, a portion of the fee collected
6 shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Association for the Deaf License
7 Plate Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.15 of this title;

8 37. Oklahoma City Zoo License Plate - such plates shall be
9 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma
10 City Zoo. The license plates shall be designed in consultation with

13 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be

22 section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited in the
23 Hospice and Palliative Care License Plate Revolving Fund created in
24 Section 1104.21 of this title;

17 design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to the

19 Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued. Subject to the

21 License Plate is hereby reauthorized effective November 1, 2015;

22 54. Crossings Christian School License Plate - such plates
23 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
24 support for Crossings Christian School located in Oklahoma City.

1 The license plates shall be designed in consultation with the
2 administration of Crossings Christian School. The Tax Commission
3 shall be authorized to enter into a licensing agreement with
4 Crossings Christian School for any licensing fees which may be
5 required in order to use the school's logo or design. The licensing
6 agreement shall provide for a payment to the Crossings Christian
7 School of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license
8 plate issued;

9 55. Hilldale Education Foundation License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such
10 plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
11 demonstrate support for the Hilldale Education Foundation. The
12 license plates shall be designed in consultation with the

15 with the Hilldale Education Foundation for any licensing fees which

19 authorized to enter into a licensing agreement with the Oklahoma

24 more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

7 Revolving Fund created in Section 156 of Title 62 of the Oklahoma

9 60. Remembering Fallen Heroes License Plate - such plates shall
10 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support
11 for Concerns of Police Survivors, Inc. Such plates shall be
12 designed in consultation with the Oklahoma chapter of Concerns of
13 Police Survivors, Inc. As provided in this section, an amount of
14 the fee collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Concerns of
15 Police Survivors License Plate Revolving Fund created in Section
16 1104.27 of this title; and

17 61. Oklahoma Aeronautics Commission License Plate - such plates
18 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
19 support for the Oklahoma aviation industry and to promote awareness
20 of aviation and aerospace. Such plates shall be designed in
21 consultation with the Oklahoma Aeronautics Commission and shall be
22 issued to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from
23 one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized plates. Twenty-four
24 Dollars (\$24.00) of the fee collected shall be deposited in the

1 Oklahoma Aeronautics Commission Revolving Fund, for expenditure as
2 provided in Section 91 of Title 3 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

3 C. The fee for such plates shall be Thirty-five Dollars
4 (\$35.00) and shall be in addition to all other registration fees
5 provided by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act. The
6 fee shall be apportioned as follows:

7 1. Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) or any other amount as provided in
8 this title of the fee shall be apportioned as provided or deposited
9 in a fund as specified within the paragraph authorizing the special

11 2. Eight Dollars (\$8.00) of the fee shall be deposited in the
12 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund to be used for the

16 provided in Section 1104 of this title.

17 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 3 O.S. 2011, Section 91, as
18 amended by Section 21, Chapter 304, O.S.L. 2012 (3 O.S. Supp. 2016,
19 Section 91), is amended to read as follows:

20 Section 91. There is hereby created in the State Treasury a
21 revolving fund for the Oklahoma Aeronautics Commission to be
22 designated as the Oklahoma Aeronautics Commission Revolving Fund.
23 The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year
24 limitations, and shall consist of a monthly allocation by the

Oklahoma Tax Commission of Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000.00) from the motor fuel excise tax levied and collected pursuant to the provisions of Title 68 of the Oklahoma Statutes, such amount being a part of the estimated amount of tax paid on gasoline consumed by engines to propel aircraft in Oklahoma, sale of surplus property, fees and receipts collected pursuant to the Oklahoma Open Records Act, donations, gifts, bequests, contribution, devices, interagency reimbursements, federal funds unless otherwise provided by federal law or regulation, sale of leases and aircraft registration fees and taxes, fees authorized by Section 1135.5 of Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes or any other source. All monies accruing to ~~said~~ the fund are hereby appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the Oklahoma Aeronautics Commission for airport construction and rehabilitation programs ~~and~~, general operations of the agency, for promoting the awareness of aviation and aerospace, and providing financial support for aviation education programs to address the need for a skilled and competent aviation workforce. Expenditures from ~~said~~ the fund shall be made upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by law with the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services for approval and payment.

SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.

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
