COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to schools; directing State Board of Education to promulgate rules for restraint and seclusion; requiring rules to align with specified guidelines; prescribing school boards of education to adopt and adhere to rules; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 13-117 of Title 70, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. The State Board of Education shall promulgate rules which align with the restraint and seclusion guidelines provided by the United States Department of Education.

B. School boards of education shall adopt and adhere to the rules promulgated by the State Board of Education as provided in subsection A of this section.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
