COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to public health and safety; amending 63 O.S. 2011, Section 1-210, which relates to city-county boards of health; authorizing the county board of health to create a city-county board of health after a certain date; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 63 O.S. 2011, Section 1-210, is amended to read as follows:

Section 1-210. ~~There~~ Prior to November 1, 2018, there is hereby created in any county of the State of Oklahoma with a population of more than two hundred twenty-five thousand (225,000), according to the latest Federal Decennial Census, and containing within its boundaries a city with a population of more than one hundred fifty thousand (150,000), according to the latest Federal Decennial Census, a city-county board of health composed of nine (9) members. Beginning on and after November 1, 2018, a county board of health

1 may create in any county of the State of Oklahoma with a population
2 of more than two hundred twenty-five thousand (225,000), according
3 to the latest Federal Decennial Census, and containing within its
4 boundaries a city with a population of more than one hundred fifty
5 thousand (150,000), according to the latest Federal Decennial
6 Census, a city county board of health composed of nine (9) members.

7 The membership of the Board shall be composed of five members
8 appointed by the city council of such city, or city commission,
9 whichever applies, and four members appointed by the board of county
10 commissioners of such county. Each member shall serve a term of six
11 (6) years, except, that of the members initially appointed by the
12 city council, or city commission, whichever applies, one member
13 initially appointed shall serve a term of two (2) years, one member
14 initially appointed shall serve a term of three (3) years, one
15 member initially appointed shall serve a term of four (4) years, one
16 member initially appointed shall serve a term of five (5) years, and
17 one member initially appointed shall serve a term of six (6) years;
18 provided, however, that in any such city having a city board of
19 health created under its charter provisions, the members of such
20 city board of health and the tenure of the city board of health
21 members of the city-county board of health shall be coterminous with
22 the city board of Health. Of the members initially appointed by the
23 board of county commissioners, one member initially appointed shall
24 serve a term of two (2) years, one member initially appointed shall

1 serve a term of three (3) years, one member initially appointed
2 shall serve a term of five (5) years, and one member initially
3 appointed shall serve a term of six (6) years. The appointing
4 authority shall appoint new members as the terms of office of its
5 initial appointees expire. Wherever a city-county board of health is
6 now in existence, the current board members shall be retained, until
7 the termination of their present appointment, by the appointing
8 authorities.

9 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.

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
