17	thereafter, no state employee shall receive a salary which is
18	greater than ninety percent (90%) of the salary paid to the chief
19	executive officer of the agency, board, commission, department or
20	program in the executive branch of state government by which the
21	employee is employed.
22	B. The provisions of this section shall not apply to physicians
23	licensed by the State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision or
