L6	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
L7	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1097 of Title 22, unless there
L8	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
L9	Persons convicted in this state, who make a request for transfer
20	to another state pursuant to the Interstate Compact as prescribed in
21	Section 1093 of Title 22 of the Oklahoma Statutes, shall pay a
22	transfer application fee of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) for each
23	transfer application submitted. The transfer application fee shall
24	be paid to the Department of Corrections upon submission of the
