10 An Act relating to offender supervision; directing
11 persons requesting transfer to another state to pay a
12 transfer application fee; allowing certain action by
13 the Director; directing deposit of collected fees;
14 providing for codification; and providing an
15 effective date.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
18 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1097 of Title 22, unless there
19 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

20 Persons convicted in this state, who make a request for transfer
21 to another state pursuant to the Interstate Compact as prescribed in
22 Section 1093 of Title 22 of the Oklahoma Statutes, shall pay a
23 transfer application fee of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) for each
24 transfer application submitted. The transfer application fee shall
be paid to the Department of Corrections upon submission of the

1 transfer application. The Director of the Department or the
2 Director's designee may waive the application fee if it is
3 determined that the payment of the fee will constitute an undue
4 economic burden on the offender. All fees collected pursuant to
5 this section shall be deposited into the Department of Corrections
6 Revolving Fund.

7 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.

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
