Roofing Program", appear in statute or rule, such terms shall mean the Oklahoma Optional Roofing Program.

- B. 1. Upon the effective date of this act, except for those contracts entered into before the effective date of this act, any contract for roofing repairs or replacement entered into on behalf of a state agency or political subdivision by the Office of Management and Enterprise Services utilizing an ongoing contracting program through the Oklahoma Optional Roofing Program, or a successor program authorized by statute or agency rule, that does not exceed a total of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) shall be required to utilize the Oklahoma Optional Roofing Program.
- 2. Upon the effective date of this act, except for those contracts entered into before the effective date of this act, any contract for roofing repairs or replacement entered into on behalf of a state agency or political subdivision by the Office of Management and Enterprise Services utilizing an ongoing contracting program through the Oklahoma Optional Roofing Program, or a successor program authorized by statute or agency rule, that exceeds a total of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) may utilize the Oklahoma Optional Roofing Program or may adhere to the requirements of the Public Competitive Bidding Act of 1974.
- 3. Upon the effective date of this act, except for those contracts entered into before the effective date of this act, the Office of Management and Enterprise Services shall permit no more

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than six contractors, but no less than four contractors in the same
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    region of the state to enter into contracts for roofing repairs or
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    replacement through the Oklahoma Optional Roofing Program
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    simultaneously.
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        SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
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    of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
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    declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
    be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
