2ND CONFERENCE COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to the Wildlife Conservation  
Commission; amending 29 O.S. 2011, Section 3-303,  
which relates to acquisition of property; requiring  
Senate approval for purchase or disposition of real  
property; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 29 O.S. 2011, Section 3-303, is  
amended to read as follows:

Section 3-303. A. The Commission may acquire, by purchase,  
gift, grants, grant-in-aid from the federal government, or from any  
other source public or private, all property or money necessary,

1 useful or convenient for its use in carrying out the objects and  
2 purposes of this Code.

3 B. Any and all gifts, grants, royalties and rentals received by  
4 the Commission shall, however, be allocated and used in the same  
5 manner as Wildlife Conservation Funds, except that gifts given for  
6 specified purposes by the donor shall be used for such specified  
7 purposes.

8 C. On any land acquired by the Oklahoma Wildlife Conservation  
9 Commission pursuant to the provisions of the Oklahoma Wildlife  
10 Conservation Code, after ~~the effective date of this act~~ January 1,  
11 1989, the Commission shall annually make in lieu of tax payments  
12 equal to the average ad valorem tax per acre paid on similar land in  
13 that county. ~~Said~~ The payments shall be made from any funds created  
14 in or pursuant to the authority granted by the Oklahoma Wildlife  
15 Conservation Code. The payments shall be made by the Commission  
16 within sixty (60) days from receipt of an itemized statement from  
17 the county treasurer of the county in which the land is located.

18 D. The provisions of subsection C of this section shall be  
19 applicable to any lands acquired by or on behalf of the Oklahoma  
20 Wildlife Conservation Commission pursuant to Section ~~5 of this act~~  
21 168.9 of Title 73 of the Oklahoma Statutes and the Oklahoma Capitol  
22 Improvement Authority may enter into such agreements with the  
23 Oklahoma Wildlife Conservation Commission as may be required for the  
24 Commission to make such in lieu payments with respect to real

1 property title to which is held by the Oklahoma Capitol Improvement  
2 Authority until title is transferred to the Commission as provided  
3 by Section ~~5 of this act~~ 168.9 of Title 73 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

4 E. Any purchase or disposal of real property by the Commission  
5 shall be approved by the Oklahoma State Senate.

6 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
