CONFERENCE COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to swine; making it unlawful to import or possess exotic swine; authorizing the State Veterinarian to grant exceptions for zoos; providing for codification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 6-6 of Title 2, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. It shall be unlawful and be a misdemeanor in Oklahoma to import or possess exotic swine of the family Suidae. Provided, however, exotic swine species shall not include pot-bellied pigs, teacup pigs and other swine or pigs commonly owned as domestic pets.

B. The State Veterinarian may grant exceptions for importation and possession by a zoo accredited by the Association of Zoos and Aquariums.

1 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
2 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
3 declared to exist, by reason whereof this resolution shall take
4 effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
