16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
17	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
18	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-1925.5 of Title 63, unless
19	there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
20	A. Beginning December 31, 2021, an assisted living center, as
21	defined in paragraph 1 of Section 1-890.2 of Title 63 of the
22	Oklahoma Statutes, shall be required to have at least ninety-six
23	(96) hours of alternate sources of energy sufficient to operate a
24	heating and air conditioning system capable of maintaining

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    temperatures between sixty-five (65) and eighty (80) degrees

    Fahrenheit for an area of not less than one hundred (100) net square
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    feet per licensed bed capacity and provide for the safe and sanitary
    storage of food, medicines and other necessary provisions.
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        B. Notwithstanding anything in subsection A of this section to

    the contrary, an assisted living center newly licensed beginning
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    November 1, 2019, shall be required to meet the requirements
    contained in subsection A of this section upon licensure.
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        SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
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
