11 funds after student withdraws from certain class -
12 codification - effective date]

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2606 of Title 70, unless there
17 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

18 A. If a student withdraws from a class in which he or she has
19 received an award from the Oklahoma Higher Learning Access Program,
20 the awarded funds shall be returned to the Oklahoma Higher Learning
21 Access Program. The provisions of this subsection shall only apply
22 to awarded funds when a student withdraws prior to the end of the
23 add/drop period for the session in which the student is enrolled.

1 B. The Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education shall
2 promulgate rules to implement the provisions of this section.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
