L3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
L 4	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
L5	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 601.21 of Title 10, unless there
L 6	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
L7	A. There is established the "Children's Trust Fund of
L8	Oklahoma", the resources of which shall be used to award grants to

22	B. The Trust Fund may accept gifts, donations and bequests from
23	any person, foundation or entity.

- C. The Trust Fund shall be administered by the Oklahoma

 Commission on Children and Youth and governed by the Commissioners

- 6 D. The Oklahoma Commission on Children and Youth shall
 - 1. Establish a Parent Partnership Board;

- E. All funds shall be distributed through a competitive bid process and awards are to be made on an annual basis with a maximum of five (5) years for renewals.
- F. A nonprofit organization is eligible to receive funds only when the nonprofit:
- 1. Meets grant qualifications as outlined in the Request for 18 Proposals; and
- 2. Provides matching funds in an amount of ten percent (10%) of the award.
- SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 601.22 of Title 10, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

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Children and Youth.

promulgate rules to:

- A. The Children's Trust Fund of Oklahoma is created as a charitable and educational endowment fund within the Office of the Oklahoma State Treasurer. The fund shall be expended only as provided for in this section.
- B. The State Treasurer shall direct the investment of the trust fund.
- C. The State Treasurer shall annually prepare an accounting of revenues and expenditures from the Trust Fund. This accounting shall specifically identify the interest and earnings of the Trust Fund, shall describe how the amount of interests and earnings has been affected by the expanded investment and shall identify how the interests and earnings, if any, have been expended.
- D. Beginning in fiscal year 2019, all money contributed to the fund that year, plus four and twenty-five one hundredths percent (4.25%) of the twelve-quarter rolling average of the fund, including unrealized gains and losses, shall be available for disbursement upon the authorization of the Commissioners of the Oklahoma

 Commission on Children and Youth and the Parent Partnership Board of the Oklahoma Commission on Children and Youth.
- E. The Commissioners shall approve ten percent (10%) of the available funds as available to the Oklahoma Commission on Children and Youth to provide oversight, training and evaluation for the grantees.

3	G. Money granted or received as gifts or donations to the Trust
4	Fund shall be available for disbursement in accordance with this
