12	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 36 O.S. 2011, Section 6060, is
13	amended to read as follows:
14	Section 6060. A. For the purposes of this section,
15	1. "Health benefit plan" means any plan or arrangement as
16	defined in subsection C of Section 6060.4 of this title;
17	2. "Low-dose mammography" means:
18	a. the x-ray examination of the breast using equipment
19	specifically dedicated for such purpose, with an
20	average radiation exposure delivery of less than one
21	rad mid-breast and with two views for each breast,
22	b. digital mammography, or
23	<u>c.</u> breast tomosynthesis;

- 3. "Breast tomosynthesis" means a radiologic mammography

 procedure involving the acquisition of projection images over a

 stationary breast to produce cross-sectional digital three
 dimensional images of the breast from which breast cancer screening

 diagnoses may be made.
 - B. All health benefit plans shall include the coverage specified by this section for a low-dose mammography screening for the presence of occult breast cancer. Such coverage shall not:
 - 1. Be subject to the policy deductible, co-payments and coinsurance limits of the plan; or
 - 2. Require that a female undergo a mammography screening at a specified time as a condition of payment.
 - B. C. 1. Any female thirty-five (35) through thirty-nine (39) years of age shall be entitled pursuant to the provisions of this section to coverage for a low-dose mammography screening once every five (5) years.
 - 2. Any female forty (40) years of age or older shall be entitled pursuant to the provisions of this section to coverage for an annual low-dose mammography screening.
- 20 C. As used in this section, "health benefit plan" means any
 21 plan or arrangement as defined in subsection C of Section 6060.4 of
 22 this title.
- SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
