A new section of law to be codified NEW LAW in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 4019 of Title 69, unless there 14 15 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: There is hereby created the Oklahoma State Safety Oversight 16 Program. Oversight for this program will be provided by the 17 Oklahoma Department of Transportation. The Department shall develop 18 and enforce the Oklahoma State Safety Oversight Program Standards 19 for all private and public rail fixed quideway systems statewide 20 that are not administered by the Federal Railroad Administration. 21 The Department shall have the complete authority to implement, 22 enforce and oversee the Oklahoma State Safety Oversight Program in 23

3	The Department is hereby authorized to apply for, receive and
4	expend Federal State Safety Oversight Program funds in strict
5	accordance with applicable state and federal law, rules and

7	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2018.
8	SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
9	of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
10	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
11	be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
