AMENDATORY 66 O.S. 2011, Section 128, is amended to read as follows: 13 Section 128. It shall be the duty of every railroad company or 14 15 corporation doing business, or operating a line of railroad, within this state, to construct a crossing, limited to the space between 16 the tracks and two (2) feet on either side thereof, across that 17 portion of its track, roadbed or right-of-way over which any public 18 highway may run, and maintain the same that crossing unobstructed, 19 and in a good condition for the use of the public, and to build and 20 maintain in good condition all bridges and culverts that may be 21 necessary on its right-of-way at such crossing and in case. If any 22 railroad company or corporation fails so to construct and maintain 23

said crossing for thirty (30) days after written notice by the road

2	any city or town in this state, or fifty petitioners of any city or
3	town who are interested (where such work or repairs are needed), to
4	be given to the section boss, or any station agent of any railroad
5	company or corporation in the county (where such work or repairs are

7	city or town complaining, the sum of Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00)
