NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1011.15 of Title 56, unless 14 15 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: The Oklahoma Health Care Authority (OHCA) shall seek 16 Α. Medicaid waiver authority to pursue modifications to Medicaid 17 eligibility criteria so that receipt of SoonerCare coverage for 18 certain Medicaid populations is conditional upon documentation of 19 certain education, skills, training, work or job activities. 20 Oklahoma eligibility criteria is excluded from this requirement. 21 This requirement is contingent upon approval from the federal 22 Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services and available state

funding.

B. The SoonerCare eligibility criteria shall be the same as the eligibility criteria for the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance

Program (SNAP) or the Temporary Assistance for Needy Families

Program (TANF). SoonerCare eligibility modifications shall include criteria for work or job activities as required for the SNAP or TANF programs. In order for an enrollee to remain eligible for

SoonerCare, he or she shall comply with the work and job activity requirements for SNAP or TANF.

C. Exemptions to the eligibility criteria shall be the same as the exemption criteria for SNAP, TANF or Medicaid populations excluded pursuant to federal Medicaid laws and guidelines.

Populations excluded from the requirements shall include those which are excluded by SNAP, TANF or federal Medicaid laws and guidelines.

The state may adopt additional exemptions subject to agency rulemaking and federal approval.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
