6 An Act relating to commercial driver license; stating
7 certain exemption for hazardous material endorsement
8 if certain requirements are met; providing for
9 codification; and declaring an emergency.

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

11 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
12 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 14-124 of Title 47, unless there
13 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

14 Any person driving under a commercial class A license shall not
15 be required to obtain a hazardous material endorsement pursuant to
16 49 C.F.R. Section 383 if the person is:

17 1. Acting within the scope of the license holder's employment
18 as an employee of a custom harvester operation; and

19 2. Operating a service vehicle that is:

20 a. transporting diesel in a quantity of three thousand
21 seven hundred and eight-five (3,785) liters, or one
22 thousand (1,000) gallons or less, and

23 b. clearly marked with a "flammable" or "combustible"
24 placard, as appropriate.

1 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
2 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
3 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
4 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
