NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 271 of Title 19, unless there is 14 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 15 The county clerk in a county shall have the authority to employ 16 a general counsel through an outside law firm, to advise or 17 represent the county clerk and his or her office in the performance 18 of the official duties of that office. The Board of County 19 Commissioners shall approve all contracts for outside counsel. A 20 general counsel employed pursuant to this section shall be 21 compensated from the funds of the employing county office. 22 23 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby 24
