9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

10 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
11 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5051.6 of Title 63, unless there
12 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

13 To the extent allowed under federal law, any provider enrolled
14 in the state Medicaid program may bill the Oklahoma Health Care
15 Authority for Medicaid services performed up to one year after the
16 date the service was performed. If a claim is initially denied, the
17 provider may submit a subsequent claim up to one year after the date
18 the original claim was denied; provided, the provider may only
19 utilize this provision once per claim.

20 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
