Revenue from the fee levied in subsection A of this section 4 5 shall be transferred each month to the Department of Public Safety for deposit in the Motorcycle Safety and Education Program Revolving 6 Fund created pursuant to Section 40-123 of Title 47 of the Oklahoma 7 Statutes this title; provided, in no event shall the revenue 8 9 apportioned pursuant to this section exceed the 3-year average of 10 the total fiscal year amounts apportioned in fiscal years 2015, 2016 11 and 2017. Any amount in excess of the 3-year average shall be 12 placed to the credit of the General Revenue Fund.
 - C. The collection and payment of the fee specified in this section shall be a prerequisite to licensing or registration of any motorcycle.
- 16 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2018.
 - SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
