NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.269 of Title 69, unless 16 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 17 The portion of SH-66 in Rogers County beginning at the 18 intersection of County Road S4110 extending north to the 19 intersection of Fisher Road in the Town of Verdigris shall be 20 21 designated as the "Robert B. Robison Memorial Highway". 2.2 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers 23 bearing that name to be placed on the highway. 24

1 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.270 of Title 69, unless 3 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: The portion of State Highway 169 beginning at the intersection 4 5 of U.S. 266 and extending south to the intersection of East 36th Street North within the municipal limits of Tulsa shall be 6 designated as the "Sergeant Jeffrey Lee Drake Memorial Highway". 7 The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent 9 markers bearing that name to be placed on the highway. 10 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.271 of Title 69, unless 11 12 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: The bridge over Caney Creek on U.S. Highway 169, located 1.9 13 miles north of SH-20 in Rogers County, shall be designated as the 14 "SSGT Jason R. Hendrex Memorial Bridge". The Department of 15 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that 16 name to be placed on the bridge. 17 SECTION 4. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 18 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.272 of Title 69, unless 19 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 20 The section of Interstate Highway 44 between SW 104th Street and 21

SW 119th Street in Cleveland County shall be designated as the "James Robert "Bob" Kalsu Memorial Highway". The Department of
