6 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Tourism and
7 Recreation Department; creating the Oklahoma Tourism
8 and Recreation Department Reimbursement and Donation
9 Fund; specifying sources of revenue for fund;
10 providing for expenditures from funds; providing for
11 codification; providing an effective date; and
12 declaring an emergency.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2254.2 of Title 74, unless there
16 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 A. There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving
18 fund for the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department to be
19 designated the "Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department
20 Reimbursement and Donation Fund". The fund shall be a continuing
21 fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, and shall consist of
22 donations, insurance reimbursements, Federal Emergency Management
23 Agency (FEMA) payments and other reimbursement monies received by
24 the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department.

1 B. All monies accruing to the credit of the fund are hereby
2 appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the Oklahoma
3 Tourism and Recreation Department.

4 C. No monies from this revolving fund shall be transferred for
5 any purpose to any other state agency. Expenditures from the fund
6 shall be made upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer against
7 claims filed as prescribed by law with the Director of the Office of
8 Management and Enterprise Services for approval and payment.

9 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2018.

10 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
11 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
12 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
13 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
