7 An Act relating to the State Board of Career and
8 Technology Education; directing certain expenditures;
9 providing for increase in compensation for certain
10 certified personnel; providing for increase in
11 compensation for certain support employees; providing
12 for the duties and compensation of employees;
13 providing lapse dates; requiring certain budget
14 procedures; prohibiting certain budget procedures;
15 providing an effective date; and declaring an
16 emergency.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

18 SECTION 1. Of the funds appropriated to the State Board of
19 Career and Technology Education in Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1600 of
20 the 2nd Session of the 56th Oklahoma Legislature, Ten Million One
21 Hundred Eighteen Thousand Nine Hundred Seven Dollars
22 (\$10,118,907.00) shall be for the purpose of providing an increase
23 in compensation for certified personnel, as defined in Section 26-
24 103 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated to the State Board of
Career and Technology Education in Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1600 of
the 2nd Session of the 56th Oklahoma Legislature, Two Million Sixty

1 Thousand Dollars (\$2,060,000.00) shall be for the purpose of
2 providing an increase in compensation for support employees, as
3 defined in Section 26-103 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

4 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not
5 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
6 upon the Oklahoma Department of Career and Technology Education by
7 law shall be set by the Board. The Oklahoma Department of Career
8 and Technology Education for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2019,
9 shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-
10 time-equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures
11 for capital and special projects, except as may be authorized
12 pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the
13 Oklahoma Statutes:

16 SECTION 4. Appropriations made to the State Board of Career and
17 Technology Education in Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1600 of the 2nd
18 Session of the 56th Oklahoma Legislature, not including
19 appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for
20 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2019 (hereafter FY-19), or may be
21 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2020 (hereafter FY-20).
22 Funds budgeted for FY-19 may be encumbered only through June 30,
23 2019 and must be expended by November 15, 2019. Any funds remaining
24 after November 15, 2019, and not budgeted for FY-20 shall lapse to

1 the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.
2 Funds budgeted for FY-20 may be encumbered only through June 30,
3 2020. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2020 shall lapse to
4 the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.
5 These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years
6 simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-19, and not required to pay
7 obligations for that fiscal year, may be budged for FY-20, after the
8 agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared and
9 submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds from
10 the FY-19 budget work program and after such revision has been
11 approved by the Office of Management and Enterprise Services.

12 SECTION 5. This act shall become effective July 1, 2018.

13 SECTION 6. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
14 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
15 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
16 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
