A. The sheriff, treasurer or assessor in a county 15 shall have the authority to employ a general counsel, either in-16 house as a staff attorney or through an outside law firm, to advise 17 or represent that officer and his or her office in the performance 18 of the official duties of that office. The Board of County 19 Commissioners shall approve all contracts for outside counsel. A 20 general counsel employed pursuant to this section shall be 21 compensated from the funds of the employing county office. 22 23 B. The sheriff may employ outside counsel pursuant to this section to provide immediate representation in a deputy-involved 24

2	involved is charged with any crime arising from the shooting.
3	SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
4	of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
5	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
