9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

10 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
11 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 150.9.1 of Title 74, unless  
12 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

13 The Oklahoma Tax Commission, Oklahoma Department of Human  
14 Services and Oklahoma Employment Security Commission shall be  
15 authorized to require agency employees in positions that have access  
16 to Federal Tax Information and data to supply all information and  
17 documentation required in order to be subjected to a criminal  
18 history search by the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation, as  
19 well as be fingerprinted for submission of the fingerprints through  
20 the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation to the Federal Bureau of  
21 Investigation for a national criminal history check. The applicable  
22 employer-agency shall be the recipient of the results of the record  
23 check. In accordance with Section 150.9 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma

1 Statutes, this includes a national criminal record with a  
2 fingerprint analysis.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
