9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

10 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
11 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 85.7j of Title 74, unless there
12 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

13 A. Upon the effective date of this act, the Office of
14 Management and Enterprise Services shall be required to combine the
15 following non-mandatory construction and property services provided
16 by the agency into one program to be managed by the Office:

- 17 1. The Roof Asset Management Program (RAMP);
- 18 2. The On-Call Consultants Program;
- 19 3. The Testing Program; and
- 20 4. The Land Surveying Program.

21 B. The Office of Management and Enterprise Services shall
22 collect a fee for services provided by the Office under the Roof
23 Asset Management Program (RAMP), or a successor program authorized
24

1 by statute or agency, of no more than one percent (1%) of the
2 roofing contract price.

3 C. Any contract for roofing repairs or replacement entered into
4 on behalf of a state agency or political subdivision by the Office
5 of Management and Enterprise Services utilizing an ongoing
6 contracting program through the Roofing Asset Management Program
7 (RAMP) or a successor program authorized by state or agency rule,
8 shall not exceed a total of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00).

9 ~~SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation~~
10 ~~of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby~~
11 ~~declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and~~
12 ~~be in full force from and after its passage and approval.~~
