6 An Act relating to fines and fees; amending 20 O.S.
7 2011, Section 1313.4, which relates to the Forensic
8 Science Improvement Revolving Fund; modifying certain
9 fees; and providing an effective date.

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

11 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 20 O.S. 2011, Section 1313.4, is
12 amended to read as follows:

13 Section 1313.4. A. In addition to the penalty assessments and
14 fees imposed by Sections 1313.2 and 1313.3 of this title, any person
15 convicted of any offense, including traffic offenses, but excluding
16 parking and standing violations, punishable by a fine of Ten Dollars
17 (\$10.00) or more or by incarceration, or any person forfeiting any
18 bond when charged with any offense, shall be ordered by the court to
19 pay a Forensic Science Improvement Assessment in the amount of ~~Five~~
20 ~~Dollars (\$5.00)~~ Ten Dollars (\$10.00) for each offense. The
21 assessment shall be in addition to, and not in substitution for, any
22 and all fines and penalties otherwise provided by law for the
23 offense. The assessment shall be collected at the time and in the
24 manner as the fees provided in Sections 1313.2 and 1313.3 of this

1 title. Each municipal court clerk is authorized to retain five
2 percent (5%) of the assessment collected by each municipal court
3 clerk pursuant to the provisions of this section. All court clerks
4 shall send the assessments collected to the Oklahoma State Bureau of
5 Investigation for deposit into the Forensic Science Improvement
6 Revolving Fund created by Section 150.35 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma
7 Statutes less any amount authorized to be retained. The deposits of
8 funds collected pursuant to the provisions of this section shall be
9 due and payable as required in subsection H of Section 1313.2 of
10 this title. Any funds deposited as required by this section shall
11 be listed as a separate item from other deposits made pursuant to
12 Sections 1313.2 and 1313.3 of this title.

13 B. As used in this section, "convicted" and "court" shall have
14 the same meaning as defined by Section 1313.2 of this title.

15 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
