9	Department of Education, in certain consultation, to study shared administrative services of school
10	districts; providing guidelines for study; directing the State Board of Education to publish certain list

13	Education to establish certain districts to provide certain shared services.

15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
16	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 1, Chapter 403, O.S.L.
17	2014 (70 O.S. Supp. 2016, Section 1210.285), is amended to read as
18	follows:
19	Section 1210.285. A. The Within thirty (30) days of the
20	effective date of this act, the State Department of Education, in
21	consultation with the Office of Educational Quality and
22	Accountability, shall begin studying shared administrative services
23	of school districts in the state. The study shall take into
24	<pre>consideration:</pre>

- 1 1. Ways to reduce administrative costs, eliminate duplicative
 2 overhead costs and improve efficiency among school district
 3 operations;
 - 2. The physical size of school districts, including the square mileage of the district and its proximity to another school district or districts;
 - 3. The average daily membership (ADM) of the school districts;
 - 4. The performance of school districts based on student assessments required by Section 1210.508 of this title and the annual reports required by Section 1210.545 of this title; and
 - 5. The financial stability of the school districts.
- B. 1. By December 1, 2018, the State Board of Education shall
 publish a list of all dependent and independent school districts
 that it recommends to share administrative services.
 - 2. The State Board of Education shall provide districts included in the list published pursuant to paragraph 1 of this subsection the opportunity to be heard. The Board shall notify the superintendent and school board members of districts included in the list of the time, date and place of the meeting. The chair of the State Board of Education may set time limits on individual presentations.
- C. Following the meetings required by subsection B of this
 section, the State Department of Education may shall establish
 Regional Education Administrative Districts (READs) which may shall

- provide shared administrative services to school districts

 throughout the state that choose to participate. The Department

 shall provide information to school districts to educate districts

 about the functions and services which may be provided by READs.

 The information shall be disseminated to school districts through

 regional education officers and in any other manner deemed

 appropriate by the Department.
 - B- D. The administrative services provided by READs may include but not be limited to treasurer services, accounting services, purchasing services, warehouse and distribution services, human resources services, construction management, maintenance, risk management, information technology services, special education coordination, curriculum coordination, speech pathologist services, reading specialist services, transportation services, cafeteria services and shared superintendent services. Any personnel operating under a READ may be housed at a local technology center school site.
 - C- E. If the State Department of Education finds a currently operating regional or interlocal cooperative providing services to school districts, the Department may provide support to the cooperative.
 - D. F. READs may receive financial support from participating school districts from money appropriated for state aid purposes.

 The State Board of Education may determine the range of fees due to

READs for basic costs of providing services, taking into

consideration the minimum amount necessary for operation of a READ,

the number and size of participating school districts and the

geographic size of the READ service area. No fees shall be required

of school districts pursuant to this act that are greater than fees

charged school districts pursuant to similar programs.

E. G. 1. If two school districts enter into a mutual contract with a superintendent pursuant to Section 5-106A of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes this title, both districts may receive a discounted fee, to be determined by the State Board of Education, for participating in a READ.

2. If three or more school districts enter into a mutual contract with a superintendent pursuant to Section 5-106A of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes this title, the districts may receive an appropriately discounted fee, to be determined by the State Board of Education, for participating in a READ.

F. H. Participation in READs shall be voluntary.

 $\overline{\text{G.}}$ I. The State Board of Education shall promulgate rules to implement the provisions of this section.
