12	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 6-112, is
13	amended to read as follows:
14	Section 6-112. A. Every licensee shall have his or her driver
15	license in his or her immediate possession at all times when
16	operating a motor vehicle and shall display the same upon . Upon
17	demand of a peace officer, the licensee shall produce and provide
18	physical possession of the driver license to the peace officer. Any
19	person violating this subsection shall, upon conviction, be guilty
20	of a misdemeanor and shall be punished as provided for in Section
21	17-101 of this title.
22	B. Any person charged with violating this section who produces
23	in court, on or before the court date, a driver license issued to
24	him or her and valid at the time of his or her arrest shall be

1	entitled to dismissal of such charge without payment of court costs
2	and fine.
3	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
