NEW LAW 13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 229.1 of Title 72, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 14 The Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs is authorized 15 and directed to relocate the Oklahoma Veterans Center at Talihina, 16 17 Oklahoma, to a new location eligible for recognition and certification by the United States Department of Veterans Affairs as 18 a State Veterans' Home. It is the intent of the Oklahoma 19 Legislature that the new location be within forty (40) miles of the 20 current location and within the city limits of a municipality having 21 at least eight thousand (8,000) in population according to the 22 latest Federal Decennial Census. 23 24

1	B. The Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs is further
2	authorized and directed to proceed with the development of a new
3	facility to assume the operations of the Oklahoma Veterans Center
4	presently located in Talihina, Oklahoma, subject to such
5	geographical constraints as may be imposed by the United States
6	Department of Veterans Affairs. It is the intent of the Oklahoma
7	Legislature that the new Veterans Center be constructed within forty
8	(40) miles of the current location and within the city limits of a
9	municipality having at least eight thousand (8,000) in population
10	according to the latest Federal Decennial Census.
11	SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
12	of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
13	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
14	be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
