11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 70 O.S. 2011, Section 1210.192, is
13 amended to read as follows:

14 Section 1210.192. A. Any minor child, through the parent,
15 guardian, or legal custodian of the child, may submit to the health
16 authority charged with the enforcement of the immunization laws of
17 this state:

18 1. A certificate of a licensed physician as defined in Section
19 725.2 of Title 59 of the Oklahoma Statutes, stating that the
20 physical condition of the child is such that immunization would
21 endanger the life or health of the child; or

22 2. A written statement by the parent, guardian or legal
23 custodian of the child objecting to immunization of the child;

1 whereupon the child shall be exempt from the immunization laws of
2 this state.

3 B. Each school district in this state shall report the number
4 and type of exemptions from vaccinations as provided by subsection A
5 of this section to the State Department of Health. Such information
6 shall be submitted to the Department on or before July 1st of each
7 year, and shall include information from the most recently completed
8 school year.

9 C. The State Department of Education and the State Department
10 of Health shall promulgate rules to implement this section.

11 ~~SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2017.~~

12 ~~SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation~~
13 ~~of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby~~
14 ~~declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and~~
15 ~~be in full force from and after its passage and approval.~~
