7 An Act relating to opiate antagonists; amending  
8 Section 1, Chapter 322, O.S.L. 2013 (63 O.S. Supp.  
9 2016, Section 1-2506.1), which relates to persons  
10 authorized to administer; permitting certain  
11 employees of the Oklahoma State Bureau of  
12 Investigation to administer; and providing an  
13 effective date.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 1, Chapter 322, O.S.L.  
16 2013 (63 O.S. Supp. 2016, Section 1-2506.1), is amended to read as  
17 follows:

18 Section 1-2506.1. A. First responders shall have the authority  
19 to administer, without prescription, opiate antagonists when  
20 encountering an individual exhibiting signs of an opiate overdose.  
21 For the purposes of this provision, a first responder shall include:

- 22 1. Law enforcement officials;
- 23 2. Emergency medical technicians;
- 24 3. Firefighters; and

4. Medical personnel at secondary schools and institutions of higher education; and

5. Forensic laboratory personnel of the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation as designated by the Executive Director.

B. Any first responder administering an opiate antagonist in a manner consistent with addressing opiate overdose shall be covered under the Good Samaritan Act.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
