13	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5028.1 of Title 63, unless there
15	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
16	A. The Oklahoma Health Care Authority, with assistance from the
17	Department of Human Services and the Department of Mental Health and
18	Substance Abuse Services, shall initiate a request for information
19	for care coordination models for newborns through children eighteen
20	(18) years of age in the custody of the Department of Human
21	Services.
22	B. Any request for information shall require consideration of
23	and incorporate efforts to continue the implementation of relevant
24	initiatives as provided by the Master Settlement Agreement

2	Services.
3	C. The Oklahoma Health Care Authority, with assistance from the
4	Department of Human Services and the Department of Mental Health and
5	Substance Abuse Services, shall provide a summary of the request for
6	information responses to the President Pro Tempore of the Oklahoma
7	State Senate, the Speaker of the Oklahoma House of Representatives
8	and the Governor on or before January 1, 2018.
9	D. The Oklahoma Health Care Authority Board shall promulgate
10	rules to implement the provisions of this section.
11	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
