7 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Health Care  
8 Authority; creating the Nursing Facility Supplemental  
9 Payment Program Revolving Fund; specifying contents  
10 of fund and authorized expenditures; providing for  
11 codification; providing an effective date; and  
12 declaring an emergency.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1011.13 of Title 56, unless  
16 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 A. There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving  
18 fund for the Oklahoma Health Care Authority to be designated the  
19 "Nursing Facility Supplemental Payment Program Revolving Fund". The  
20 fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year  
21 limitations, and shall consist of:

22 1. All monies received by the Authority from hospitals pursuant  
23 to the Nursing Facility Supplemental Payment Program;

24 2. Any interest or penalties levied and collected in  
conjunction with the administration of this act; and

1        3. All interest attributable to investment of money in the  
2 fund.

3        B. All monies accruing to the credit of the fund are hereby  
4 appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the Authority for  
5 the purposes of:

6        1. Transferring funds for the state share of supplemental  
7 payments for the Oklahoma Medicaid Program; or

8        2. Transferring funds for the state share of administrative  
9 expenses incurred by the Authority or its agents and employees in  
10 performing the activities authorized by the Nursing Facility  
11 Supplemental Payment Program.

12        C. Expenditures from the fund shall be made upon warrants  
13 issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by  
14 law with the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise  
15 Services for approval and payment.

16        SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2017.

17        SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
18 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby  
19 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
20 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
