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7 An Act relating to public finance; amending Section 1
8 of Enrolled Senate Bill No. 17 and Section 3 of
9 Enrolled Senate Bill No. 749 of the 1st Session of
10 the 56th Oklahoma Legislature, which relate to
11 revolving funds; clarifying monies to be deposited to
12 certain revolving funds; providing an effective date;
and declaring an emergency.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 1 of Enrolled Senate Bill
15 No. 17 of the 1st Session of the 56th Oklahoma Legislature is
16 amended to read as follows:

17 A. There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving
18 fund for the Oklahoma Historical Society to be designated the "1921
19 Tulsa Race Riot Centennial Memorial Revolving Fund". The fund shall
20 be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, and
21 shall consist of all monies received by the Oklahoma Historical
22 Society from appropriations, donations or any other source and
23 designated for the purpose set forth in this section. All monies
24 accruing to the credit of the fund are hereby appropriated and may

1 be budgeted and expended by the Oklahoma Historical Society for the
2 purpose of commemoration of the centennial of the 1921 Tulsa Race
3 Riot. Expenditures from the fund shall be made upon warrants issued
4 by the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by law
5 with the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise
6 Services for approval and payment.

7 B. Any funds in the revolving fund created in Section 8201.2 of
8 Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes on the effective date of this act
9 shall be transferred to the 1921 Tulsa Race Riot Centennial Memorial
10 Revolving Fund.

11 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY Section 3 of Enrolled Senate Bill
12 No. 749 of the 1st Session of the 56th Oklahoma Legislature is
13 amended to read as follows:

14 There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund
15 for the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry to be
16 designated the "Urban Gardens Grant Revolving Fund". The fund shall
17 be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, and
18 shall consist of all monies received by the State Board of
19 Agriculture from state-appropriated funds, federal funds, donations,
20 grants and contributions from any public or private source and
21 designated for the purpose set forth in this section. All monies
22 accruing to the credit of the fund are hereby appropriated and may
23 be budgeted and expended by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture,
24 Food, and Forestry for the purpose of administering the Urban

1 Gardens Grant Act. Expenditures from the fund shall be made upon
2 warrants issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as
3 prescribed by law with the Director of the Office of Management and
4 Enterprise Services for approval and payment.

5 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 2017.

6 SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
7 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
8 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
9 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
