12	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
13	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 450 of Title 72, unless there is
14	created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
15	A. Any employee of the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs
16	may be granted administrative leave with pay for volunteer service
17	activities under such terms and limitations as the Executive
18	Director may establish, in service to veterans or dependents of
19	veterans in the State of Oklahoma that meet one or more of the
20	following criteria:
21	1. The activity is directly related to the Department's

23	2. The activity is sponsored or sanctioned by or in partnership

3	B. Leave shall be as brief as permitted under the circumstances
