7 An Act relating to the Uniform Controlled Dangerous
8 Substances Act; amending 63 O.S. 2011, Section 2-206,
9 as last amended by Section 3, Chapter 390, O.S.L.
10 2017 (63 O.S. Supp. 2017, Section 2-206), which
11 relates to Schedule II; modifying inclusions; and
12 providing an effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 63 O.S. 2011, Section 2-206, as
15 last amended by Section 3, Chapter 390, O.S.L. 2017 (63 O.S. Supp.
16 2017, Section 2-206), is amended to read as follows:

17 Section 2-206. The controlled substances listed in this section
18 are included in Schedule II.

19 A. Any of the following substances except those narcotic drugs
20 listed in other schedules whether produced directly or indirectly by
21 extraction from substances of vegetable origin, or independently by
22 means of chemical synthesis, or by combination of extraction and
23 chemical synthesis:

24 1. Opium and opiate, and any salt, compound, derivative, or
preparation of opium or opiate;

2. Any salt, compound, isomer, derivative, or preparation thereof which is chemically equivalent or identical with any of the substances referred to in paragraph 1 of this subsection, but not including the isoquinoline alkaloids of opium;

3. Opium poppy and poppy straw; or

4. Coca leaves except coca leaves and extracts of coca leaves from which cocaine, ecgonine, and derivatives of ecgonine or their salts have been removed; cocaine, its salts, optical and geometric isomers, and salts of isomers; ecgonine, its derivatives, their salts, isomers and salts of isomers; or any compound, mixture or preparation which contains any quantity of any of the substances referred to in this paragraph. Ioflupane is excluded from this paragraph.

B. Any of the following opiates, including their isomers, esters, ethers, salts, and salts of isomers, esters and ethers, when the existence of these isomers, esters, ethers, and salts is possible within the specific chemical designation:

1. Alphaprodine;

2. Anileridine;

3. Bezitramide;

4. Dihydrocodeine;

5. Diphenoxylate;

6. Fentanyl;

7. Hydromorphone;

- 22 24. Racemorphan;
- 23 25. Etorphine Hydrochloride salt only;
- 24 26. Alfentanil hydrochloride;

1 27. Levo-alphaacetylmethadol;

2 28. Codeine;

3 29. Hydrocodone;

4 30. Morphine;

5 31. Remifentanyl;

6 32. Sufentanyl; or

7 33. Tapentadol.

8 C. Any substance which contains any quantity of:

9 1. Methamphetamine, including its salts, isomers, and salts of
10 isomers;

11 2. Amphetamine, its salts, optical isomers, and salts of its
12 optical isomers;

13 3. Nabilone; or

14 4. Lisdexamfetamine.

15 D. Unless specifically excepted or unless listed in another
16 schedule, any material, compound, mixture, or preparation, which
17 contains any quantity of the following substances having stimulant
18 or depressant effect on the central nervous system:

19 1. Phenmetrazine and its salts;

20 2. Methylphenidate, including its salts, isomers and salts of
21 isomers;

22 3. Amobarbital;

23 4. Pentobarbital;

24 5. Secobarbital; or

6. Ethylphenidate.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
